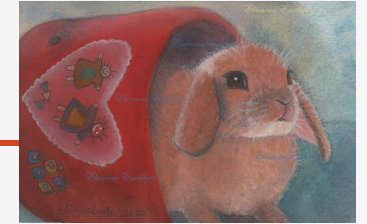


→ The Fallacy of the Middle Class: Overcoming Social Resentment (III)
